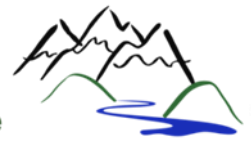

- Must be able to pass Background checks.
- Be available Monday through Saturday
- Be able to bend, twist, lift and be on feet for extended periods.
